

## Explanation of Input Data for LEA Export Certificates through AgSource

Visible ID-list number on visible tag (will be labeled Buyer ID on certificate)

Fair Mgt ID- list FAIR program management number

Eartag 1-list metal ear tag in left ear

Eartag 2-list metal ear tag in right ear

Birth Date- list birth date of heifer or see Age

Breed-list two character breed of heifer (HO,BS,GU,JE, etc.)

Reg No-list American ID, registration number, RFID or AIN number of heifer

\*\*If heifer was pasture breed, skip next two fields and list data in the next three fields

AI Date- list date when heifer was inseminated

Service Sire-list NAAB code or registration number of AI bull (this information will be used to cross reference the bull in the USDA database and list PTA data-NAAB code is preferable)

Begin Pasture Dt-list date when heifer entered pasture

End Pasture Dt	Pasture Sire	Dam Origin	Dam ID	Sire ID	Photo	Dam Ctry	Sire Ctry

End Pasture Dt-list date when heifer was removed from pasture

Pasture Sire-enter some form of ID for pasture bull (name, eartag, registration number, or American ID)

Dam Origin-list state code of dam; this is used to determine which state average production prints on the certificate

Dam ID-list American ID, registration number, RFID or AIN number, name or visible ID of heifer's dam

Sire ID-list NAAB code, registration number or name (NAAB is preferable because it can be used to cross reference the bull's registration number so both can be listed on certificate)

Photo-list the electronic file name of the heifer's photo (.jpg format is preferable and photo files must be supplied on CD or DVD)

Dam Ctry-list country code for dam if not USA (CAN,SWE,FRA,DEU, etc.)

Sire Ctry-list country code for sire if not USA (CAN,SWE,FRA,DEU, etc.)

All the above information does not have to be supplied for each heifer. AgSource will print your certificates as complete or incomplete as suits your export service. Data should be supplied in a current version of MS Excel or similar spreadsheet. See the example spreadsheet and use it as a template to enter your data.
